




## **Artist Statement**


In the work, birds are used as symbols of nocturnal darkness of the subconscious arena:

Title: An Unspoken Soliloquy Medium: Oil on Canvas Size: 42 x 56 Inches






Title: A Self from a Distant Land Watches Over






