ARTIST STATEMENT:

No one is perfect! Our imperfections are part of us being human. But are we humane?

The phrase "I'm only human!", often used as a crutch in life has concealed more sins than mistakes. It frequently ignores the naive, gives ground to nuisance and vindicates the diabolical. It keeps rendering the context of honour, love and respect while playing with the desires of living and fulfilment.

'ONLY HUMAN' is an exploration of remembrances of such realities investigating the civil and the civilized, the jested and the justified, the treasured and the terrified, the muted and the martyred.

The artist captures the fragility of life by transforming empty bullet vessels into diminutive sculptures. The sensitivity of the material symbolizes the vulnerabilities and complexities of human life. The amalgamation of plastic toys adds on to individuality of Khan's artworks and reveal her quirky take as a sculptor on the tradition of miniature painting and vintage staged photography.

Profile

Sara Khan Pathan is a multidisciplinary artist and educator working in sculpture, illustration, animation, photography, and painting. As a visual artist, her art is born from her resolute devotion to Pakistan exploring cartography, nature, impacts of violence, identity and socio-political complexities of displacement. She is a Fine Arts and Islamic Arts miniature painting instructor and senior Thesis Advisor at the Dept. Of Visual Studies (University of Karachi) Sara has recently acquired professional training in Museum Collection Care from Manchester, UK and is spreading awareness about the value of Art conservation. Her work has been showcased nationally and internationally as well.

A few of her recent projects include the research and execution of 'Machi-Wachi', transforming the shape of an island into the world's first Environmental Strategy Board game, and creative curation of the South Asian food anthology book 'Manachi'. She also curated a Tactual Art project, 'Treasures of Mind' for the Chalta Phirta Museum which made The State Bank Museum one of the first in Pakistan to exhibit a permanent collection catering to the visually impaired. Her original design for the reverse vinaigrette was selected for the 75th Commemorative Banknote published by the State Bank of Pakistan in September 2022.
