To evoke the unknown, I weave symbolic landscapes and figures, exploring the union of opposites. 'Some Kind of Marriage' navigates the soul's longing for unity, echoing the eternal return. This transformative odyssey invites contemplation on inner balances and the universal quest for harmony.

1) Cosmic Sandwich

Defiance of gravity and convention. Initial impressions could be of duality, two lands, mirrored yet distinct. Upper and lower realms: spiritual and material worlds. Roots in the shared sky, symbolizing spiritual growth or upheaval. Colour dichotomy: Red (passion, life) below, Yellow/Ochre (wisdom/clarity) above.

2) Beyond Horizon

This painting explores the human experience of disorientation and reorientation. The figure, turned away from the viewer, embodies the search for inner balance amidst life's turmoil. The inverted landscape symbolizes the blurred boundaries between reality and subconscious. This juxtaposition invites contemplation on the harmonious coexistence of opposing forces.

3) Harvest

Death-Rebirth Cycles: Universal theme. Acceptance of Mortality: Transmutation. Rebirth's promise.

4) Shadowed Radiance

The interplay between light and darkness symbolizes the balance between intuition and ego. The black sun represents the acknowledgment of our shadow aspects, while the red floral field embodies the suppressed ego, allowing intuition to flourish. This harmony enables a deeper understanding of existence, transcending binary distinctions.

5) Luminescent

This painting invites introspection for transcending shadows. Emerging from the darkness of abuse, finding inner light. From oppression to empowerment. A journey through the veil of deception, beyond ego's shadows. Being one's own light, the light that was birthed by darkness.

6) Eid

This painting examines the intricate dance between light and shadow, abundance and sacrifice. The seated woman's enigmatic gaze invites contemplation on the weight of collective burdens, while the goat's presence underscores the hidden costs of our choices.

7) Raising the Bride

In this painting the 'bride' could be seen as a metaphor for the subconscious and the collective unconscious. Raising the Bride would mean acceptance of death by killing the ego, and embracing intuition. On a different note, the 'bride' could be seen as a metaphor for the motherland. This painting serves as a ritualistic homage to the feminine, intuitive forces guiding the soul.

8) The Scarlet Sensation

This painting embodies the essence of feminine creative power, embracing sexual expression and the cyclical forces of nature. As a symbol of Mother Earth's fertility, she represents the transformative energy that nurtures growth and renewal. This artwork invites the viewer to contemplate the profound connections between creativity, abundance, and the human experience.

9) Tableau of Consuming Thoughts
