



Artist statement

Danish Ahmed's solo show delves into a space outside our overcrowded and constrained physical world. Through his work, he endeavors to visualize a realm where unadulterated, original forms exist in their most rudimentary state untainted by the force of time or the restraints of materiality. Taking inspiration from metaphysical and spiritual traditions like Plato's Theory of Forms and Sufi metaphysics, Ahmed views this realm as the origin and destination of all material being. His art practice involves imagining configurations of these pristine forms, attempting harmony and alignment that is reflective of the unchallengeable nature of a higher reality.

The visual language of his work employs rhombus-like shapes serving as portals, or vistas, into this incorporeal cosmos advocating a spatial dimension of their own. Clouds are used metaphorically within his compositions hinting at the fleeting nature of perception and the search for deeper truth. Ultimately, Ahmed's work aims to evoke a sense of harmony and connection with the unseen.

















Title: Untitled IV (diptych)




Title: Untitled V (diptych)

Profile

Danish Ahmed is a visual artist and academic with three decades of experience in the field. He is currently an Associate Professor at the Indus Valley School of Art & Architecture, where he previously led the Foundation Programme for five years. Before that, he dedicated 17 years to the Textile Institute of Pakistan, serving as the Head of the Textile Design Technology Programme.

Ahmed holds an MFA research degree from the University of New South Wales (UNSW), Sydney, Australia. His work has been featured in numerous group exhibitions across Pakistan, along with a solo show in 2010 at Cross Art Projects in Sydney. Most recently, in 2022, he showcased a solo exhibition at Chawkandi Gallery, Karachi.

Beyond his personal practice, Ahmed is involved in fostering artistic discourse. He is a founding member of The Karachi Collective (TKC), an online platform engaged in discourse around diverse trajectories of cultural and creative diligences rooted in the local, national, and South Asian context.


