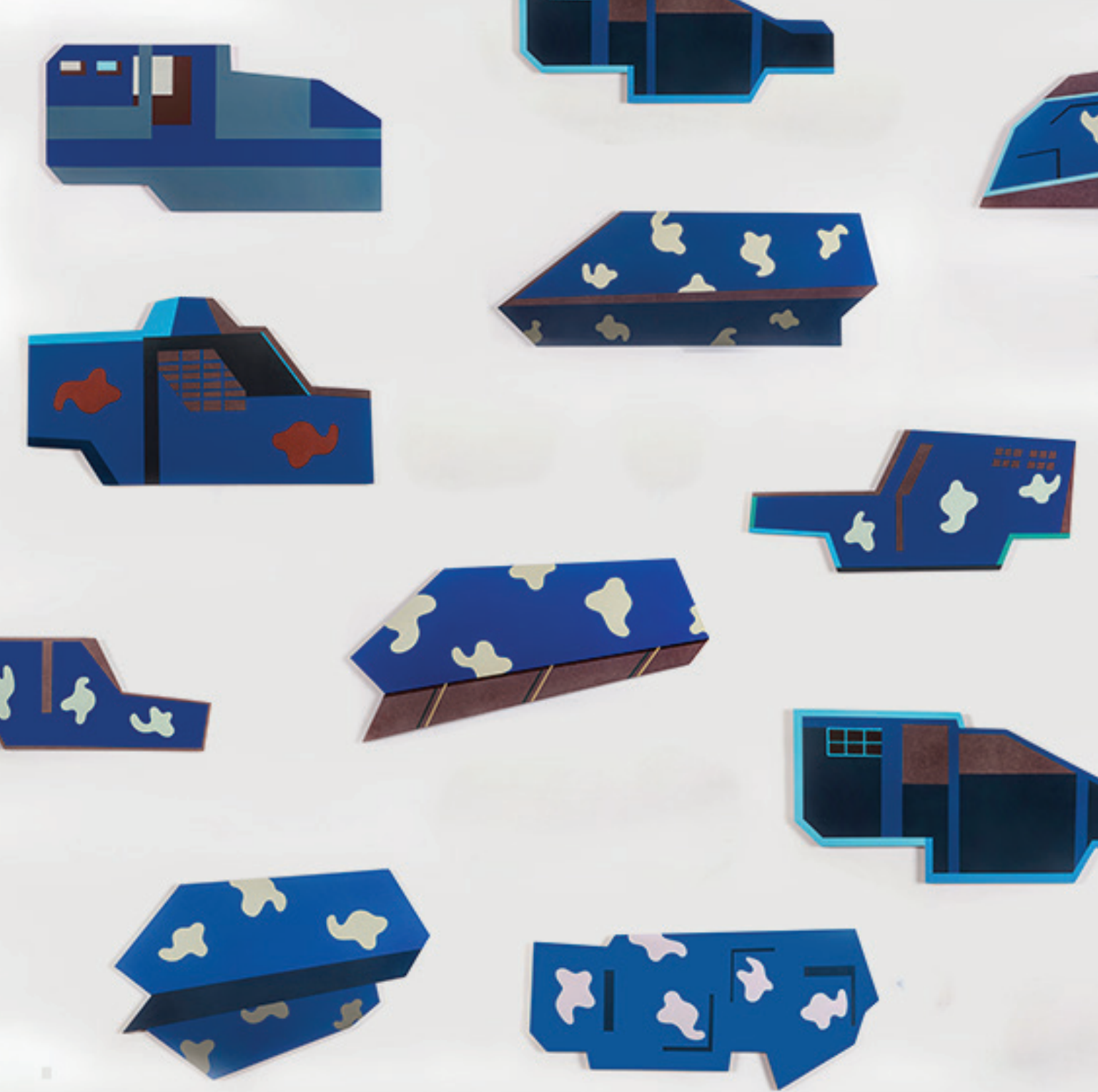

Artist statement

D.H.I. (Drawing Hostile Infrastructure) borrows the language of institutional abbreviations to examine recurring forms within Karachi's streets through drawing and painting.

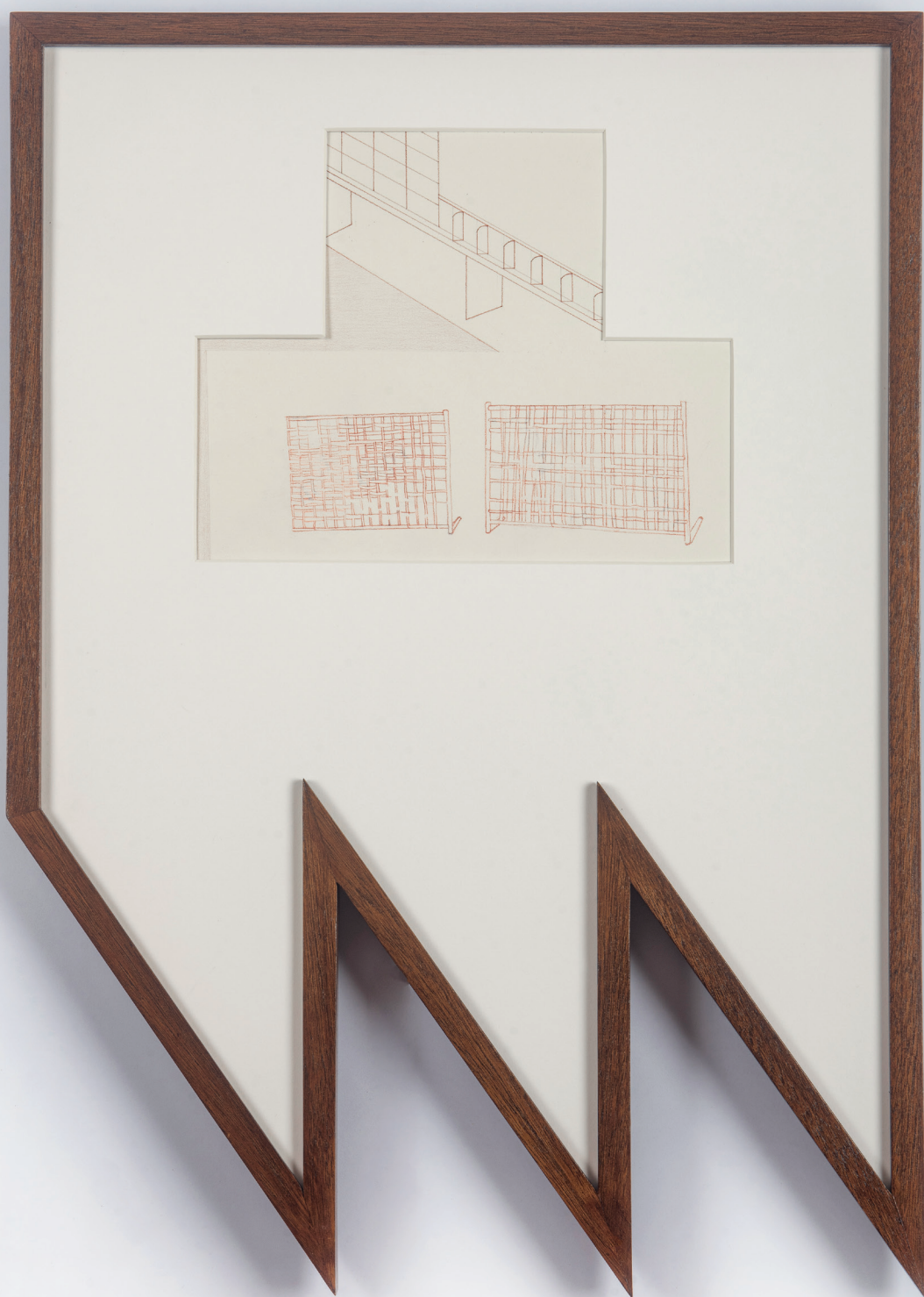
The works emerge from repeated encounters with two distinct but related conditions: improvised barricades assembled from everyday objects, and the persistent presence of security vehicles outside government and diplomatic buildings across Karachi. One is temporary, assembled and dismantled as needed; the other is institutional and enduring.

The drawings study ordinary objects that temporarily become infrastructure; *the Blue Board Paintings* turn to institutional objects that make authority visible through their continual presence. One emerges from improvised acts of governance, the other from the mechanisms of the state. Both intervene in circulation. Both occupy the street. Together they examine how power is exercised through the forms that shape everyday movement and define public space.

What keeps drawing me back to these forms is the way they resist straightforward description. A barrier supported by a plastic chair is both entirely ordinary and quietly absurd; a heavily armoured vehicle can appear unexpectedly compact, almost theatrical. I am interested in that unstable space where careful observation meets exaggeration, and where the ordinary begins to look unexpectedly strange. Drawing and painting become a way of testing that instability.

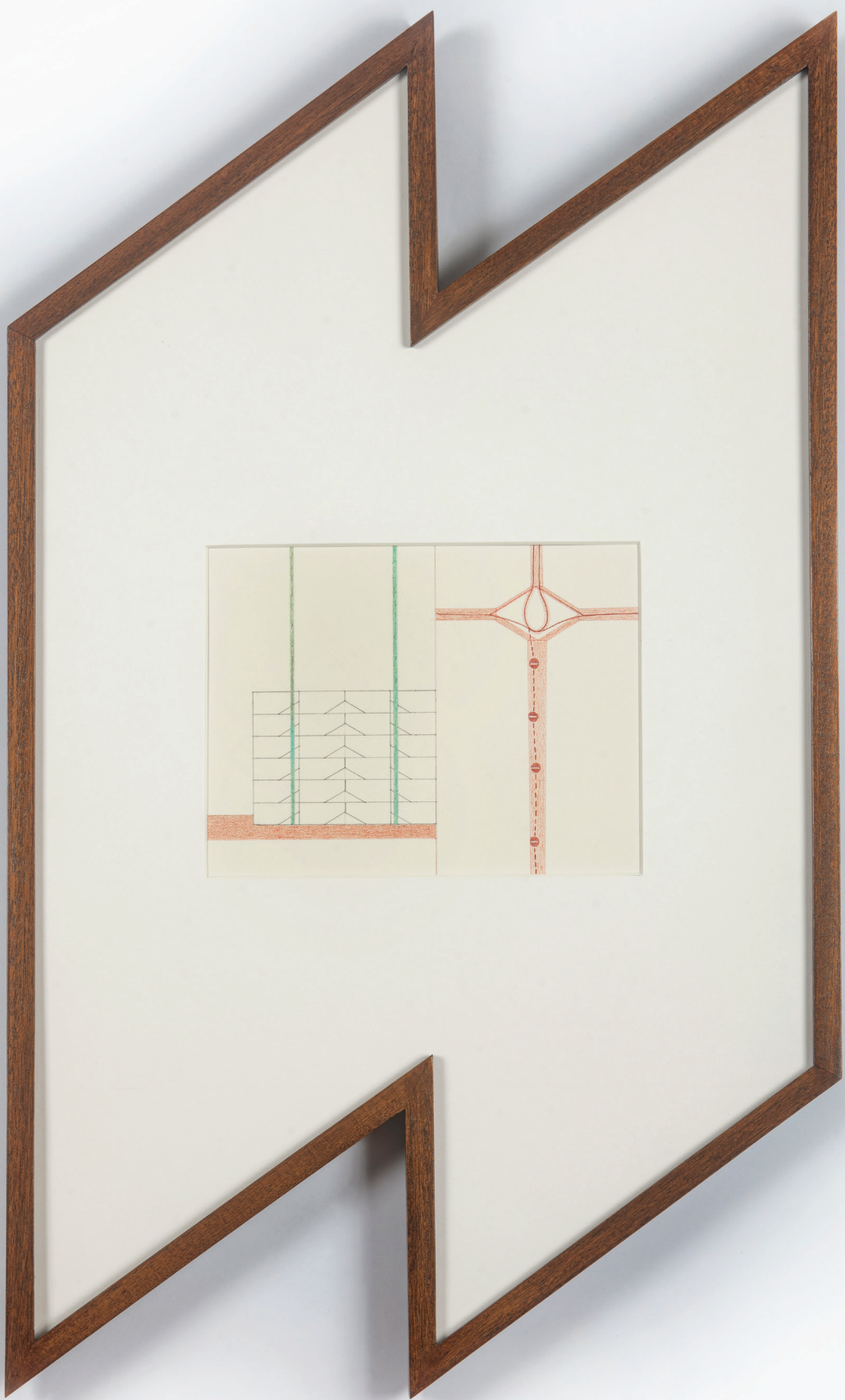


Title: Plastic Chair

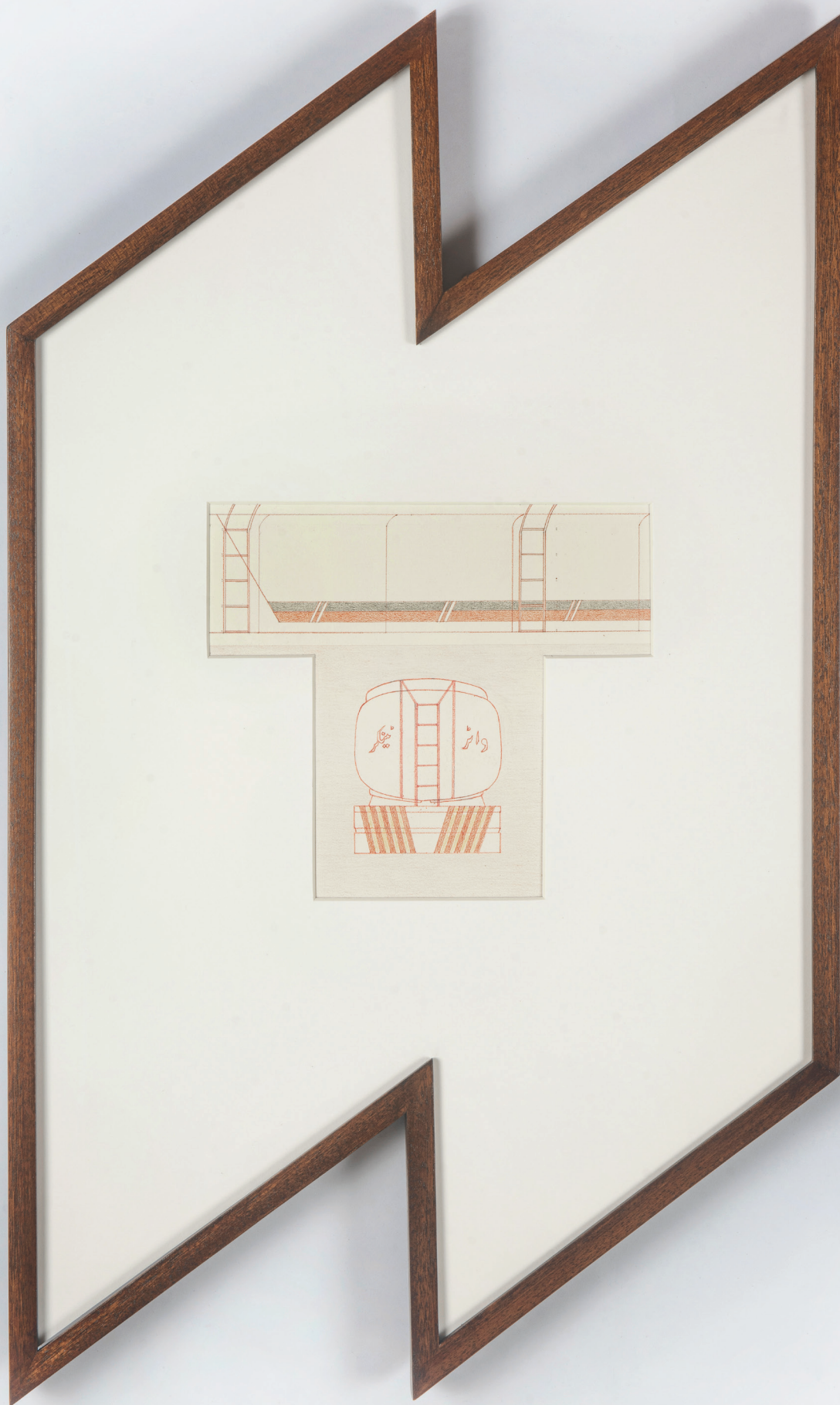

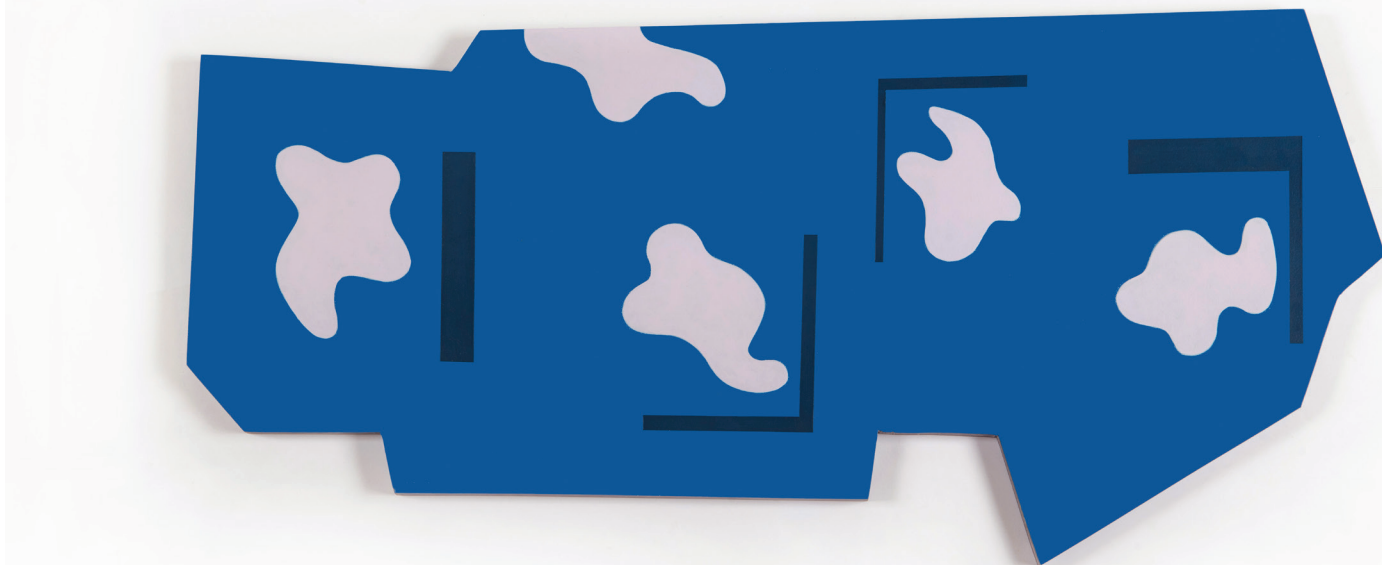
Title: Roundabout

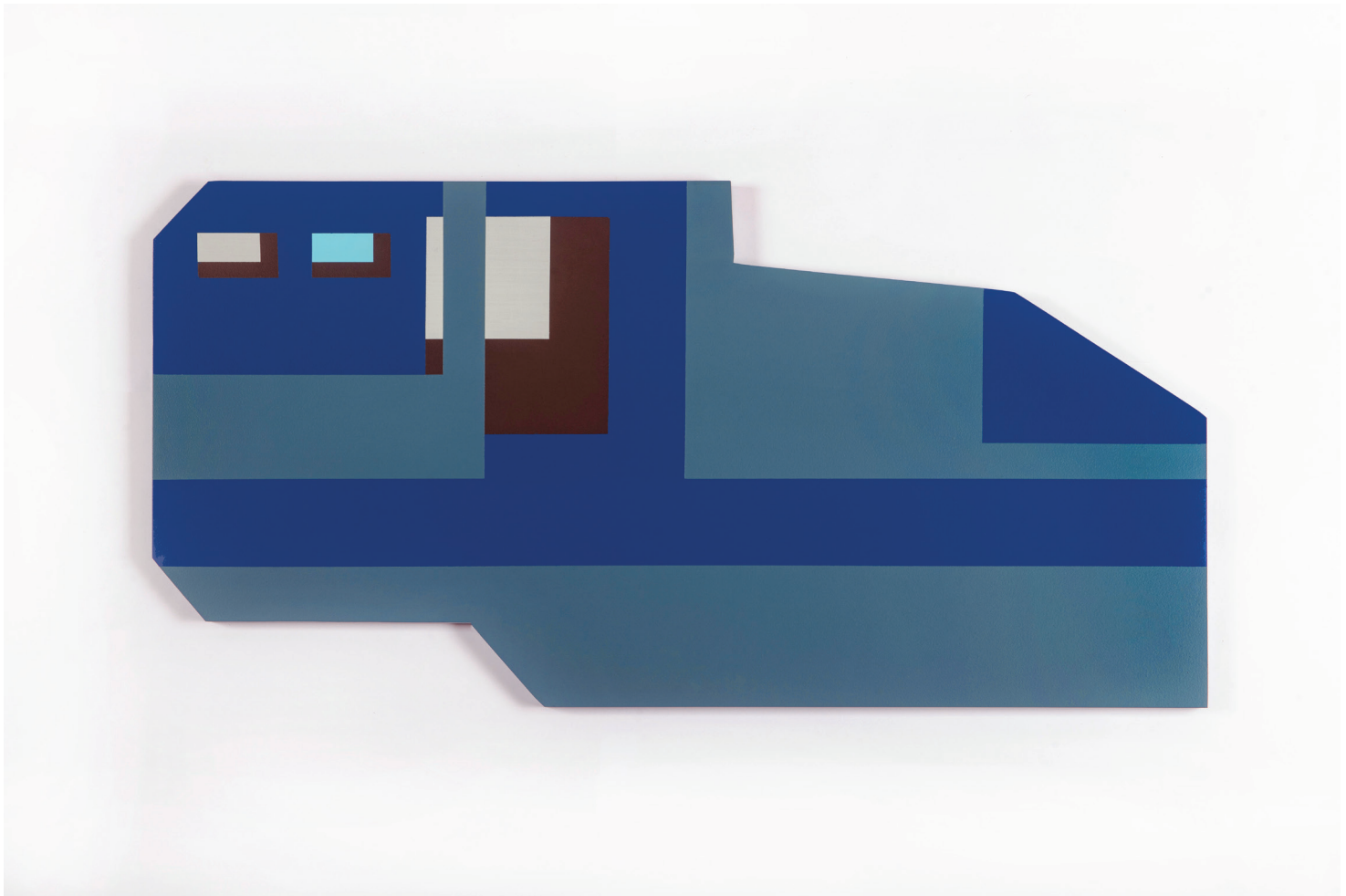
Title: Water Tanker

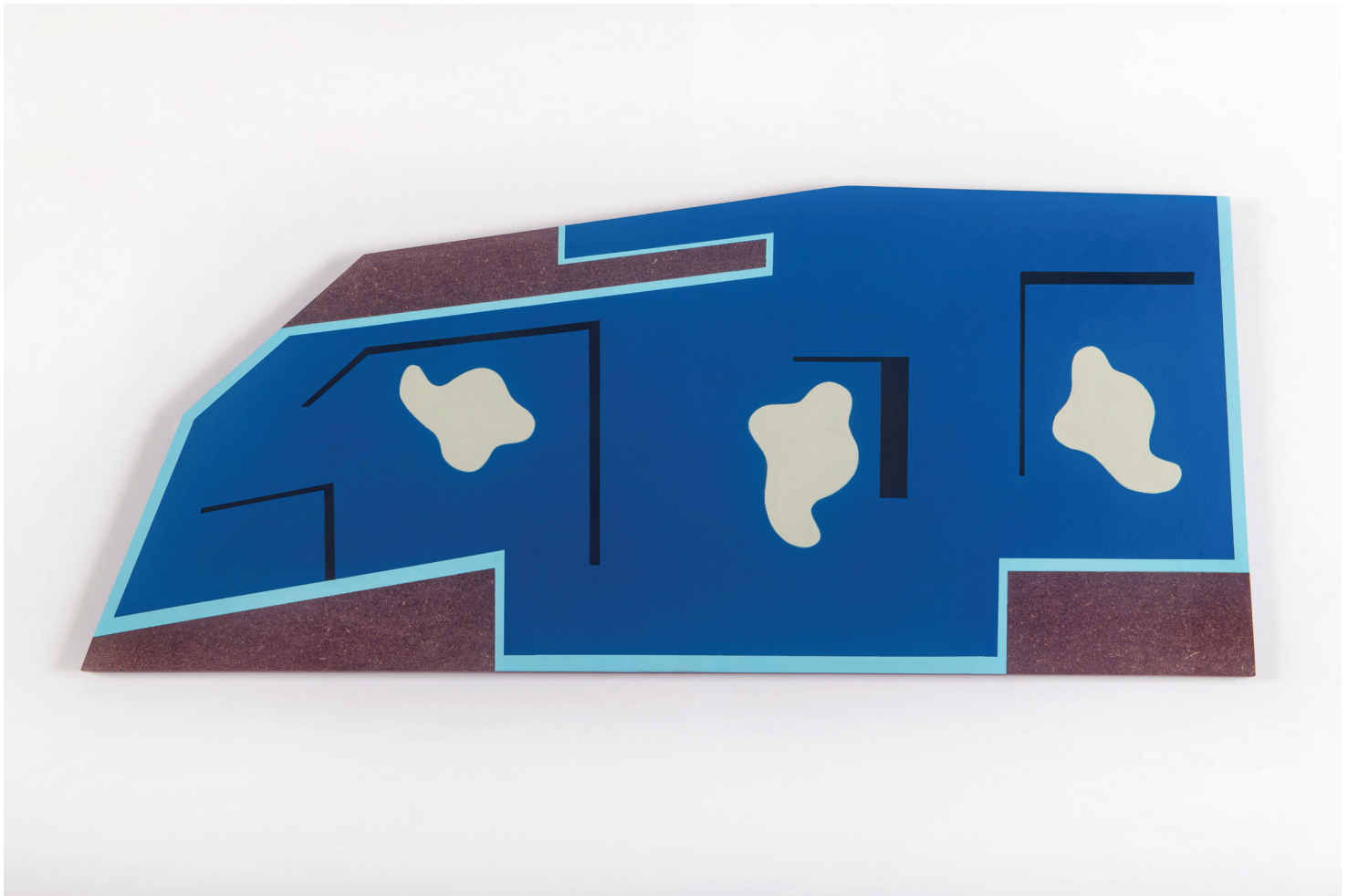
Title: Blue Board 1

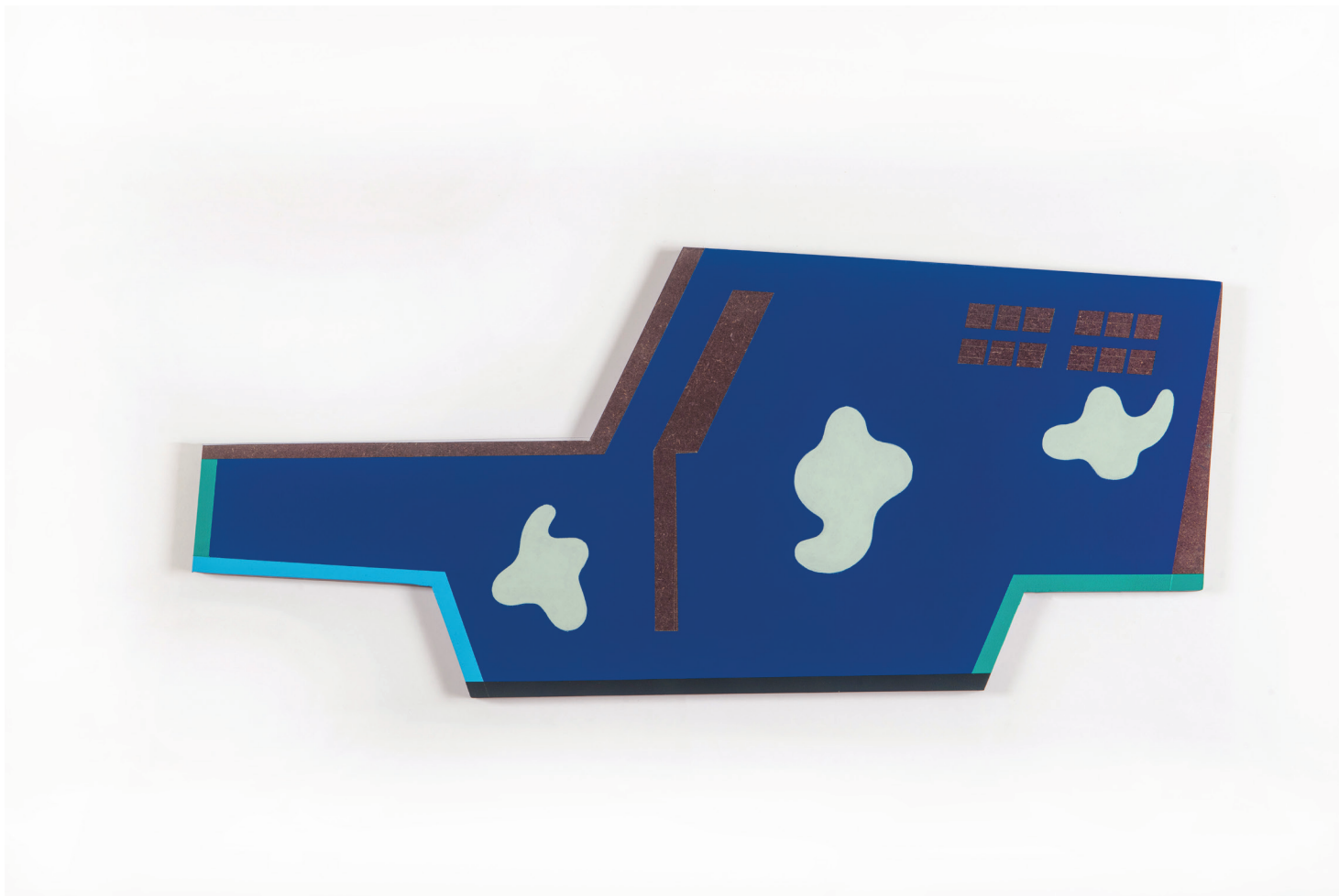


Title: Blue Board 5

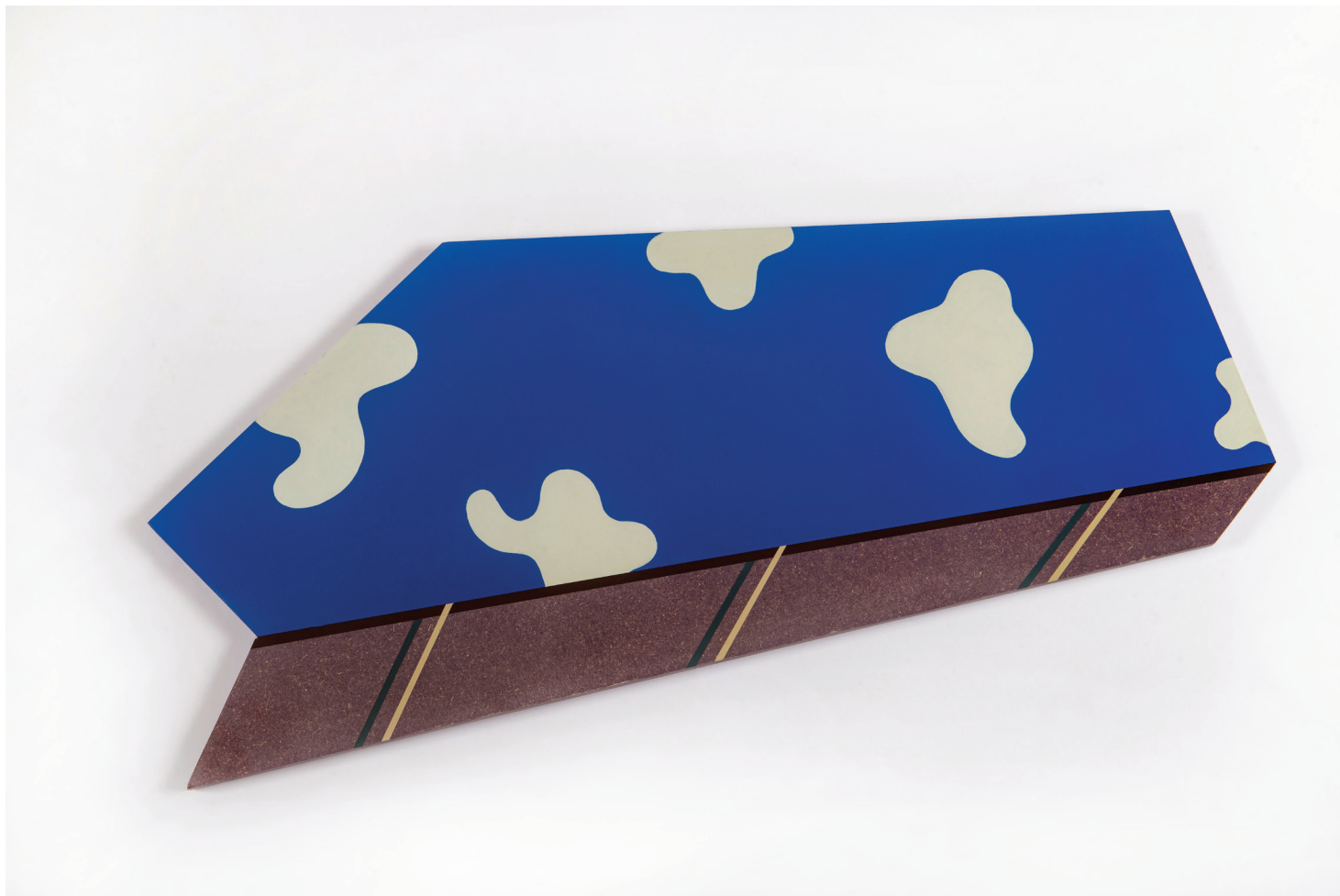

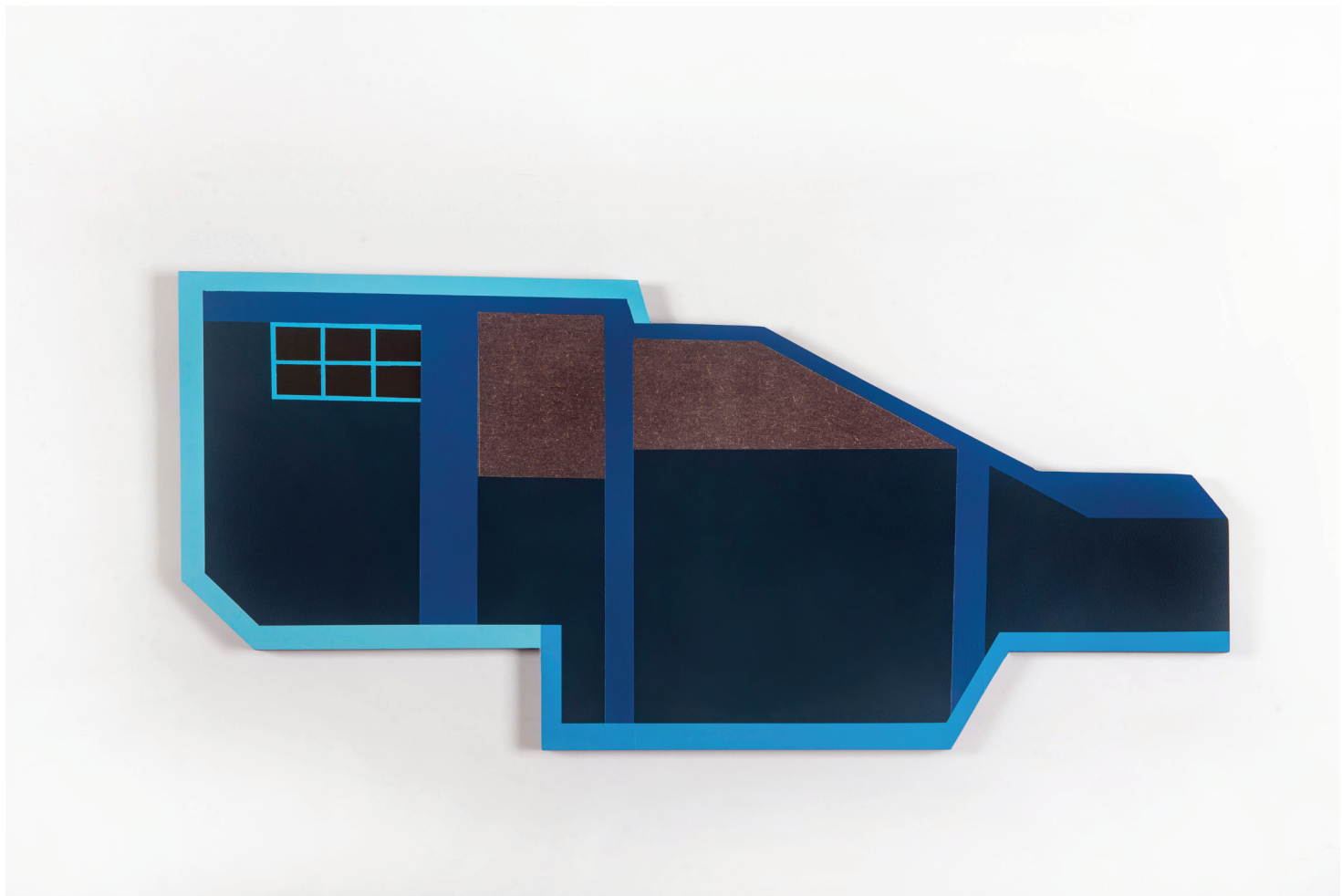
Title: Blue Board 6

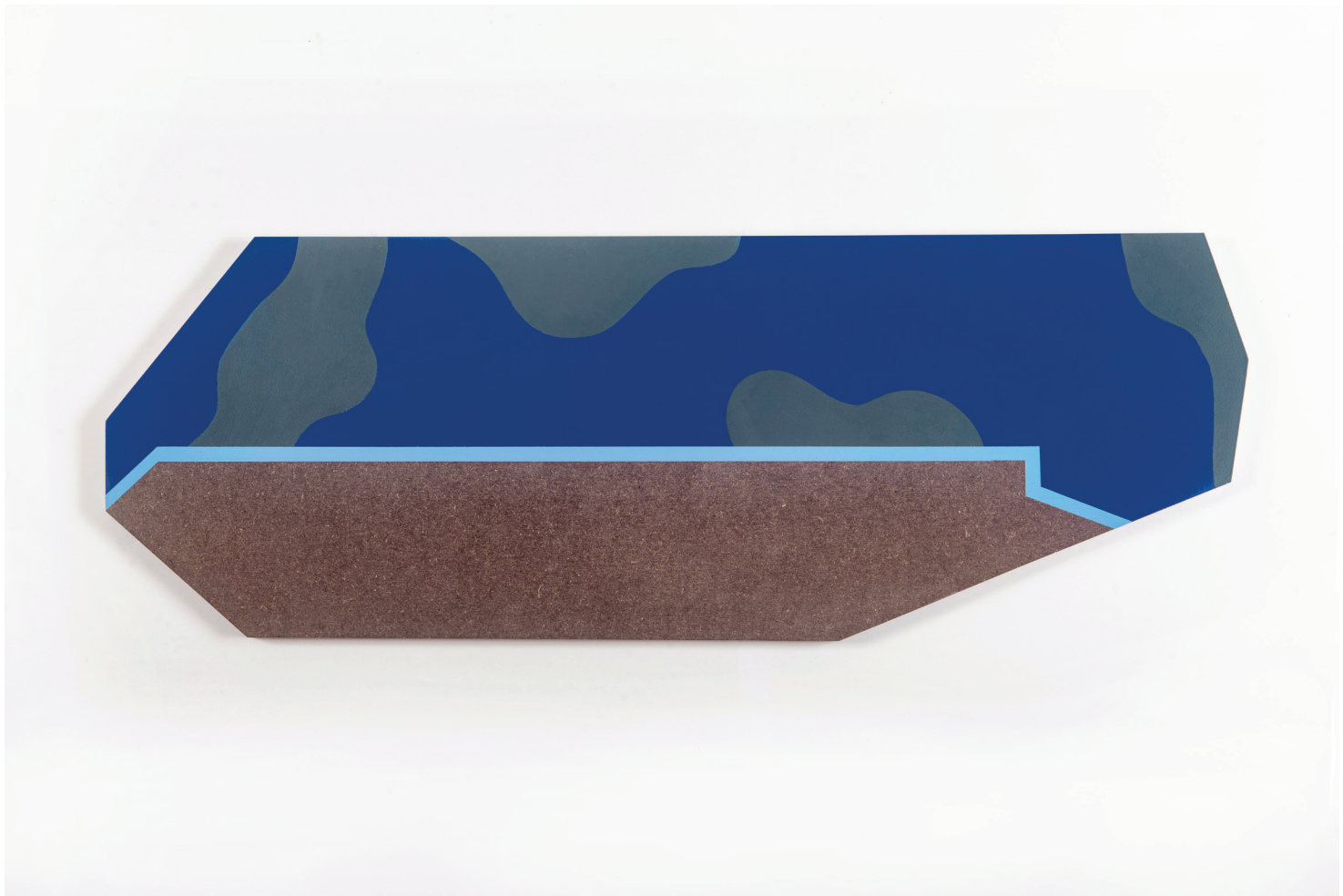


Title: Blue Board 9

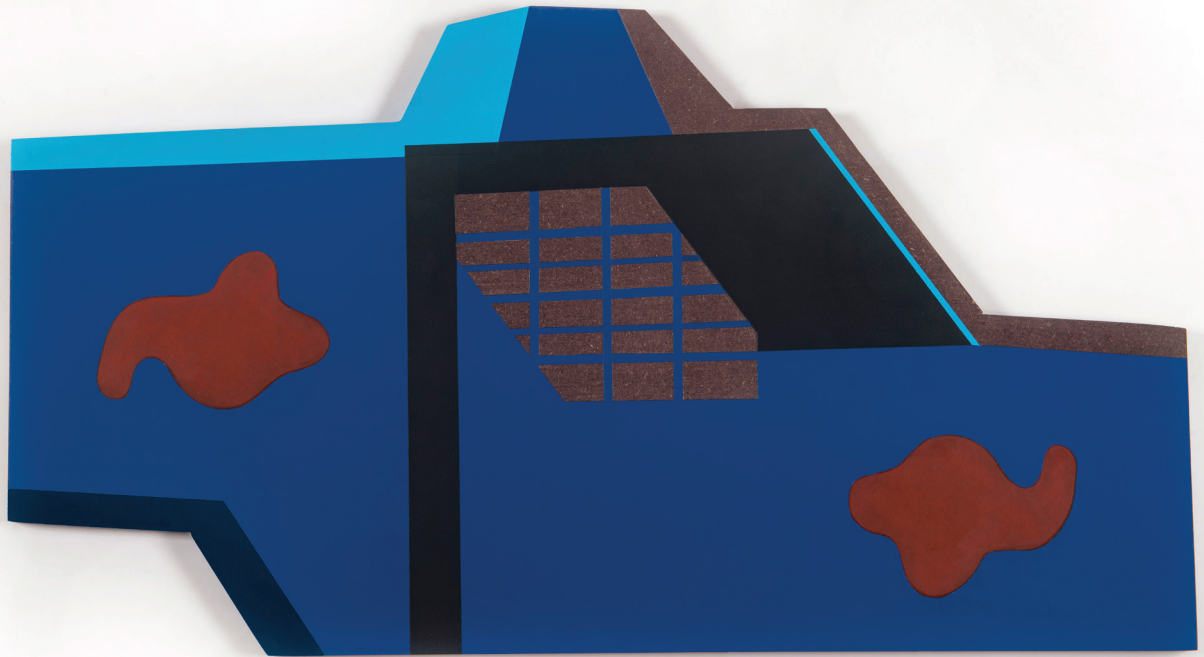


Title: Blue Board 10

Profile

Seher Naveed is a Karachi-based artist with over a decade of experience in visual arts and academia. Her practice explores the socio-political development of urban environments and their impact on everyday life, with a particular focus on Karachi and its evolving political and infrastructural landscape. Through this lens, her work examines how architecture and infrastructure reflect collective aspirations within contexts shaped by political instability.

Seher earned a BFA from the Indus Valley School of Art and Architecture (IVS), Karachi, and an MA in Fine Art from Central Saint Martins, University of the Arts London (UAL). She has exhibited widely in local and international galleries and institutions. Her work is held in the permanent collection of the Kiran Nadar Museum of Art, New Delhi. In 2026, her Tips series was commissioned by Art Jameel for the exhibition Global Positioning Systems at Jameel Art Center, Dubai. In 2015, she initiated and curated Drawing Documents, a research project and publication series examining diverse drawing practices across Pakistan.

She is currently Associate Professor at IVS, where she teaches courses in drawing and painting. She is also co-director of the Urban Repository Archive (URA), a project preserving student research on Karachi's evolving conditions, and serves on the editorial board of Hybrid, a transdisciplinary research journal at IVS.
